Programs

The one week STITCHOLOGY course is a general survey of the major stitch types, and their formation and application. It is recommended for anyone in the industry who wishes to increase their skill in identifying, applying, and evaluating stitches, seams and stitchings. This program offers a conversational knowledge of sewing machine equipment no matter who manufactures the equipment. The theory on how stitches are formed and the components that aid them, can be applied to all similar equipment producing the same stitch type.

The 5 week MECHANIC / TECHNICIAN program, is a comprehensive course designed to develop an individual into a confident, productive mechanic/technician. This course is designed with the novice in mind, but can also be very beneficial to experienced mechanics. The course is designed to teach the student the theory of how and why each of the stitches are formed, and how they will effect the machine during sewing. By learning the theory behind each stitch formation, the student can then apply this knowledge to any piece of sewing equipment, regardless of the style, type or brand.

The SPECIFIC STITCH CLASS programs are comprehensive courses designed to cover a particular stitch class or type, its application, characteristics, and the machines that produce it. As well as disassemble, assemble, adjust, sew-off and troubleshoot a particular machine style or class. Stitch classes include: Lockstitch 300, Chainstitch 400, Overedge 500, Coverstitch 600

The EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE AND QUALITY SURVEY (EMQS) program has been designed to help our customers improve the maintenance and operation of their equipment and the quality of garments being produced.

The IN-PLANT TRAINING PROGRAMS are special services offered to our customers. These programs have been designed for customers that cannot send their people to the Union Special Training Center, but still would like their people professionally trained.
